
1 Preserve me, O God, for in you have I ta - ken refuge;




I have said to the Lord, 'You are my lord, all my good de - pends on you.'




2 All my delight is upon the godly that are in the land, upon those who are no-ble in heart.




3 Though the idols are legion that ma - ny run after,




their drink offerings of blood I will not offer, neither make mention of their names up - on my lips.
