

Psalm 22 vv. 22 - 32

f 22. I will declare thy Name un - to my brethren : in the midst of the congre - ga - tion will I praise thee.

f 23. O praise the Lord ye that fear him: magnify him all ye of the seed of Jacob, and fear him all ye

seed of Israel; *2nd. mp* 24. For he hath not despised nor abhorred the low e - state of the poor :

he hath not hid his face from him, but when he called un - to him he heard him.

f 25. My praise is of thee in the great con - gre - ga - tion: my vows will I perform in the sight of them that

fear him. *mf* 26. The poor shall eat and be satisfied : *cresc.* they that seek after the Lord shall praise him,

your heart shall live for ever. *f* 27. All the ends of the world shall remember themselves,

and be turned un-to the Lord : and all the kindreds of the na - tions shall wor - ship be - fore him.

f 28. For the king - dom is the Lord's : and he is the Go - ver - nor a - mong the people.

mf 29. All such as be fat up - on earth have ea - ten and worshipped.

mp 30. All they that go down into the dust shall kneel be - fore him: and no man hath quick-ened

his own soul *f* 31. My seed shall serve him: they shall be counted unto the Lord for a ge-ne-ration.

f 32. They shall come, and the heavens shall de-clare his righteousness: unto a people that shall be born

whom the Lord hath made. *f* Glory be to the Father, and to the Son : and to the Ho-ly Ghost;
