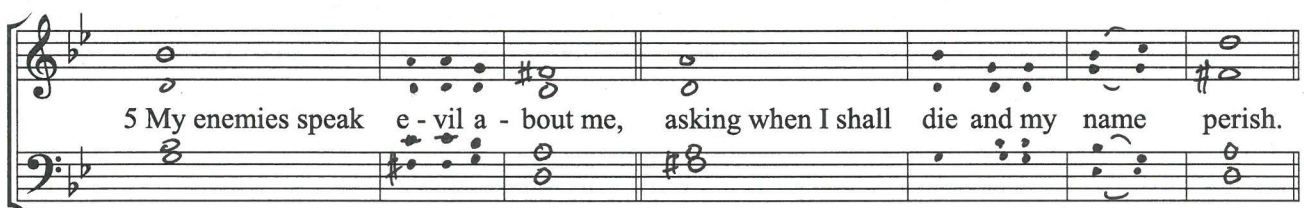
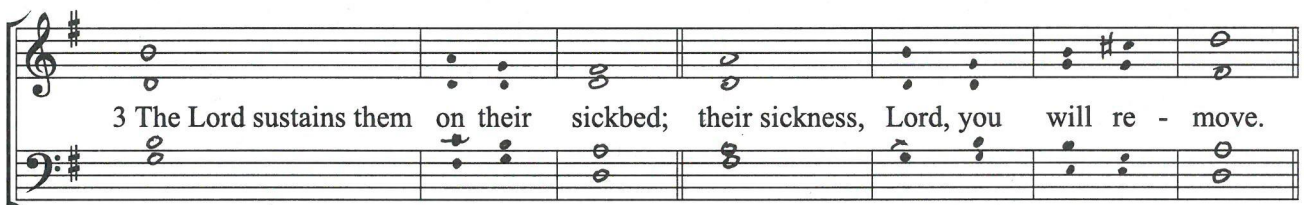
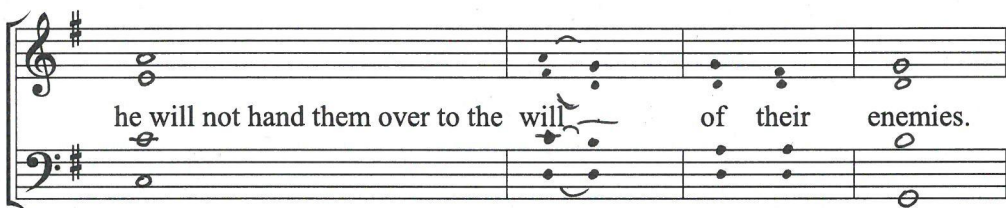
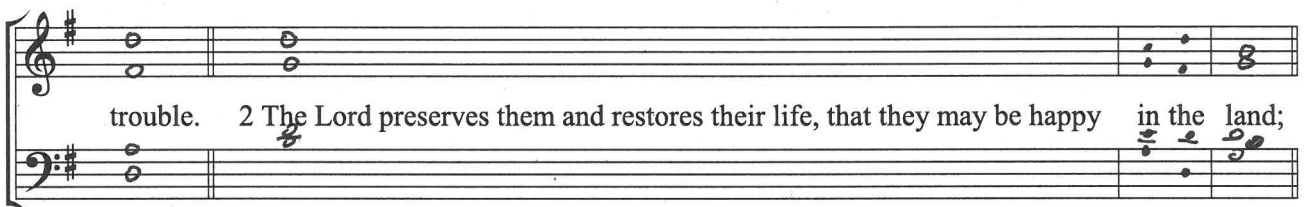
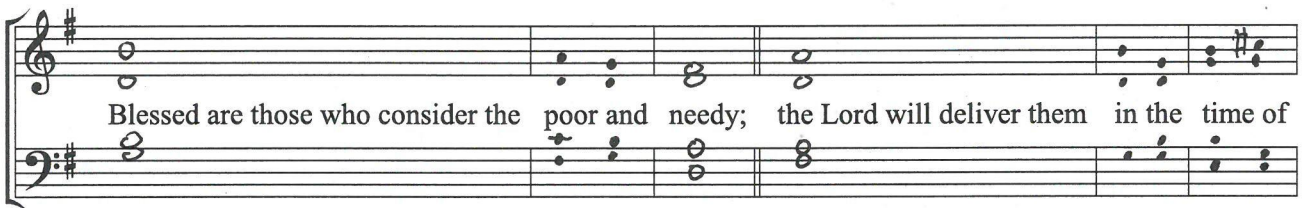
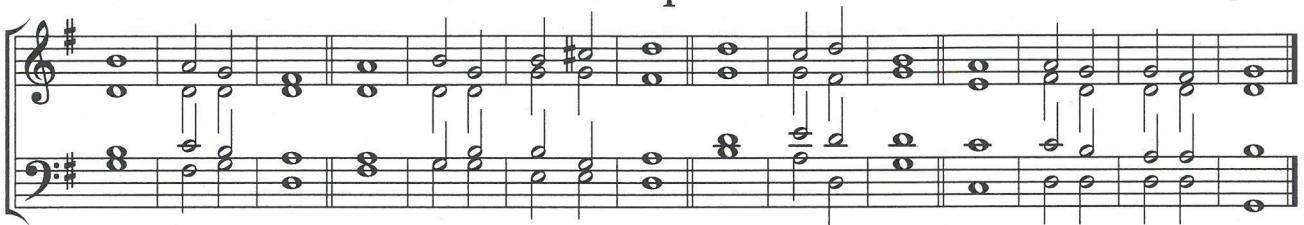


Psalm 41 Common Worship
