
f 1. O sing unto the Lord a new song: for he hath done mar-vel-lous things.




2. With his own right hand and with his ho-ly arm: hath he got-ten him-self the victory.




mf 3. The Lord de-clared his sal-vation: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the
