




Psalm 51 - Common Worship


Have mercy on me, O God, in your great goodness;




according to the abundance of your compassion blot out my of-fences.




2 Wash me thoroughly from my wicked-ness and cleanse me from my sin.




3 For I ac-know-ledge my faults and my sin is ev-er be-fore me.
